

Basecamp Trapper's Hotel - Longyearbyen

Have you experienced waking up in a hotel room and not knowing where in the world you are? Most hotels and hotel rooms get more and more alike. At Basecamp Spitsbergen we decided that our guests should never have to doubt that they are on Svalbard.

Basecamp Trapper's Hotel is situated in the middle of Longyearbyen close to pubs, restaurant, the bank and shopping mall. This is no doubt the roughest and most special hotel on Spitsbergen. The lodge is furnished with drift wood and board from Barentsburg, the Russian settlement on Spitsbergen, and slate stones and furs. You will get the feeling of entering a Spitsbergen hunter's cottage. No rooms are alike, except for the comfortable beds and bathrooms. Breakfast is served around the long table in Traveler's Club and the Cognac attic with the ceiling of glass, gives you a perfect view at the arctic light.

Basecamp Trapper's Hotel is a bed and breakfast so that you are free to enjoy the other meals of the day in the many quality restaurants and coffeehouses in the city. Here you will find everything from coffeehouses with Italian dishes to gourmet meals at Huset. You will find that the pub, which is in the same building and with the same atmosphere as the hotel, is a good place to eat.

Basecamp Trapper's Hotel has 16 rooms, including 2 suites. One of the suites has two separate bedrooms with shared bath and living room.

Guesthouse 102

Guesthouse 102 has got 31 rooms. There is a total of 8 single rooms, 19 double rooms and 4 4-bed dormitories, and they all have a sink. In both of the two floors there are several bathrooms with WC/shower. There are two TV-rooms and on the second floor a kitchen with all facilities necessary for self house-keeping. Breakfast is served on the first floor.

Guesthouse 102 is fully licensed to sell alcohol. Our guests can come for “après ski” in the evening and for example, get a cognac, a beer and Jegermeister or maybe try our 102-wine.

Breakfast, bed linen and towels are of course included in the price.

Our guests have access to a laundry machine and a storage room for luggage.

Guesthouse 102 also has bicycles for rent and wireless internet access.



Spitsbergen Hotel

With modern comfort in historic surroundings Spitsbergen Hotel offers a unique Svalbard experience. Situated on the "Hill" it has great views of Longyearbyen, the Lars glacier and the Longyear glacier. The hotel was constructed in 1947, but has been extensively refurbished over the years both internally and externally.

In the cosy lounge you can get freshly baked waffles every afternoon. Sit in front of the fire with an arctic book from our library and make the journey back to the time of Nansen and Amundsen. You can also relax in our spa department which has a sauna and massage chair.

The French inspired hotel kitchen will make your evening in the Funktionærmessen Restaurant a culinary experience.

The mining company's quarters

The hotel was originally built as accommodation/dining area for employees at Store Norske Spitsbergen Kulkompani. It was also the company's official representational building, and its interior and architecture made it Longyearbyen's grandest construction. Great effort has been placed in preserving its special history and it is well worth a cultural stroll along the hotel corridors and public areas where you'll find historic photographs, old maps and newspaper clippings.

Spitsbergen Guesthouse

Welcome to Spitsbergen Guesthouse - a reasonably priced and highly popular place to stay. Our hosts will always do their best to make sure you get a pleasant stay with us, and they are also happy to share their local knowledge about Svalbard with you.

About Spitsbergen Guesthouse

Nybyen was built as part of the post-war reconstruction programme for Longyearbyen. The settlement comprised 8 accommodation units for miners, as well as bathing facilities, a laundry and a mess hall.

Comfortable, reasonably priced accommodation

Today Spitsbergen Guesthouse offers comfortable, reasonably priced accommodation, located in the upper part of the Longyear valley and within easy reach of mountains and glaciers. The place is an excellent starting point for hiking, skiing and snowmobile trips, during both summer and winter.

75 single, double and triple rooms

Our three traditionally styled guest houses contain 75 single, double and triple rooms with a total of 136 beds. Breakfast is served in Stormessa, the old mess hall, where you'll also find the reception, a kiosk, TV and access to the Internet. Each guest house contains a kitchen with possibilities for self-housekeeping, TV-room, laundry room and an adequate number of bathrooms with showers/WCs.





Radisson Blu Hotel Polar Spitsbergen

At the world's northernmost full service hotel you stay in the heart of Longyearbyen. From your table at Brasseri Nansen you can enjoy the panoramic view towards the majestic mountain Hiorthfjellet accompanied by an excellent Arctic menu and a good selection of wines.

About the hotel

There is an open fire in the lobby where you can relax, or perhaps a visit to the relax department and a hot sauna can tempt you after a long day out in the wilderness.

Longyearbyen's most popular meeting place, the Barentz Pub, has an informal and up beat atmosphere where you can get light meals and a wide selection of drinks.

The world's northernmost full service hotel

The hotel was completed in March 1995 after a wing from the former Tråseth Hotel (The Americans' sponsor hotel during the 1994 Lillehammer Olympics) was transported to Svalbard. The service section containing the restaurant and lobby was designed by the Polish architect Krystjan Dolatowski. His inspiration taken from Hiorthfjellet gave rise to the design of the high ceiling, giving the restaurant an almost sacral atmosphere with mountains greeting you as you walk into the room.

High standard and varied facilities

The hotel has 95 rooms whereof 42 standard rooms, 25 superior rooms, 28 apartments (four-bed rooms) and 1 suite. All rooms are well equipped with on-suite, TV, telephone and mini bar. Our superior rooms are located on the first floor, and they all have view towards the mountain Hiorthfjellet or Isfjorden.

The apartments have a small kitchenette, a bedroom with bunk beds, double sofa bed in the living room, bathroom with shower/WC, and also a TV and telephone. The apartments are located in an annex to the hotel, and the walking distance between the two buildings is appr. 30 meters.

Superior rooms

Booking one of our superior rooms or the suite, we guarantee you a room with the best available view, espresso maker, bathrobe and slippers, and also the latest edition of the local newspaper, Svalbardposten, in your room. The suite has two rooms with a bathroom and a living room. From January 1st 2008 all our rooms are non smoking rooms, and we do no longer offer any rooms where smoking is allowed.

W-LAN (Wireless Internet access)

The hotel has free Internet access and they also have a PC freely available to its guests.



Mary-Ann's Polarrigg

Mary-Ann's Polarrigg offers basic, reasonably-priced accommodation to those who just need a place to stay during their Svalbard experience, and at the same time is also able to offer families, and those who like to indulge themselves, something really luxurious and different.

All guests are welcome to use of the following areas:

Kitchen

There is a kitchen with a dining area where you can make your own meals.

TV-lounge

Our TV lounge offers cable TV, several sofas and a large collection of literature about Svalbard.

Washroom

All guests have access to a washing machine, tumble dryer and drying cabinets.

The Mining Rig



The mining rig is the main rig and it is also where you will find the reception. In addition, we have a large, comfortable TV lounge and access to the kitchen. The mining rig offers 17 single rooms and 14 double rooms with bunk beds and single beds. The rooms are of a basic standard with shared showers and toilets.

Single room

17 single rooms all of a basic standard. A single bed (comfortable mattresses), writing table, a chair, reading lamp and somewhere to hang your clothes. Shared showers and toilets are just along the corridor.

Double room

The mining rig has seven double rooms with bunk beds and seven with fold-up beds. Each room has a chair, writing desk and somewhere to hang your clothes. Shared showers and toilets are just along the corridor.



The Luxury Rig

The luxury rig is the latest addition to Polarriggen, which was completed in 2004. The rooms are furnished to hotel standard and have their own bathroom. Each room is unique and decorated in a cosy fashion, with a warm atmosphere. The luxury rig has five double rooms and four family rooms.

Double room

The double rooms have a double bed (120cm) and bathroom. In addition there is a writing desk, sofa, table, radio and a mini bar.

Family room

A spacious room for up to four people. The room contains a double bed (120cm), a bunk bed and a private bathroom. In addition there is a writing table, sofa, table, radio and a mini bar.
